

FOOD ALLERGY POLICY

The LSKC strives to create and maintain a healthy and safe environment for all students.

There are a number of LSKC students who are severely allergic to nuts and other food items. For some students this is a life threatening situation.

For that reason we will be a "nut aware/allergy school".

- A written allergy plan should be submitted to your child's lead teacher prior to the first day of school and must be reviewed with the lead teacher. This should come from your child's physician.
- Children's allergy plans will be displayed prominently in the classroom for all those who come in contact with the child.
- A copy of the written allergy plan will also be kept in the main office.
- Parents of children with severe allergies should provide any necessary medications in case of a reaction (Benadryl, epipens, etc). These medications <u>must</u> be left in the main office and a medication log <u>must</u> be completed.
- Additionally, we ask if your child has an identified severe allergy that you provide the snacks and treats for your child.
- We ask all parents to prepare lunches and snacks from foods that do not contain nuts.
- LSKC promotes the policy of "nut free" foods and materials used in the classroom.
- LSKC cannot guarantee that others outside of our control (parents, grandparents, babysitters, caregivers, etc.) will abide to our food allergy policy when preparing foods for the children.
